There is also a Thursday afternoon session from 1:15pm to 2:45pm which is for children whose parents are participating in Contact's 'The Word' Bible study group. See the Contact notice board in Reception for details. Unfortunately, due to legal requirements, children who have used Crèche on a Thursday morning may not attend in the afternoon.

Who is it for?

We cater for pre-school children (up to 4 years old). Priority is given to those whose parent is studying, then to those whose parent works at Wycliffe Hall.

Registration is required for a minimum of one session per week. A maximum of 4 sessions per week may be offered. One off sessions may also be available—please see Contact's Crèche Rep.

Thursday afternoon sessions run on a first come, first served basis weekly.

How many children do we cater for?

The number of children we can have in Crèche is regulated by the Government's children:adult ratio and children:space ratio. Therefore, we care for 6 children in the morning sessions and a maximum of 20 children on Thursday afternoon

sessions (8 under 2 year olds and 12 over 3 year olds).

How much?

Currently the fee for a session is £5 for the morning sessions and free for Thursday afternoon sessions. We are thankful to the college for subsidising the afternoon sessions to encourage Bible study. The fees are reviewed annually by Crèche Management Committee (CMC).

Who looks after the children?

The crèche sessions are organised and run by the Crèche Manager, Hannie Riley, with the help of volunteers. The manager and regular volunteers are CRB checked. Parents are sometimes asked to volunteer for one session a term per day their child attends.

Why are we here?

Our purpose is for spouses of Wycliffe Hall students and staff to have time without their pre-school children to enable them to participate in academic study, to engage in Bible study individually or as part of a spouse's group, and to free up time for them to do ministry with others.

For children, we provide opportunities to be and feel involved in the Wycliffe community life by encouraging corporate play and instructing them in the Lord.

Crèche sessions

We run four morning sessions during Wycliffe Hall term time: Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 10am to 12noon. We are closed during school half terms.
