

# Travelling to Wycliffe Hall

## 54 Banbury Road, Oxford, OX2 6PW

### By bus

Wycliffe Hall is in a position just north of the city centre that is well served by buses with two bus stops directly outside the college. Oxford Bus Company route 2, and Stagecoach Oxford route 7 and 14 and all stop very near to the college. For more information contact:

### By coach

The main Oxford coach terminus is in the centre of the city at Gloucester Green and it is a 15-20 minute walk to the college, or a five minute bus journey using the routes listed above. ### By train

Regular trains run direct to Oxford from London (Paddington - approx. 55mins), Birmingham International Airport (approx. 1 hour), Birmingham (approx. 1 hour 10mins), Leeds (approx. 2 hours 10 mins), Manchester (3 hours), Newcastle (approx. 5 hours) and Edinburgh (approx 6 hours 30 mins). Oxford train station is just to the west of the city centre about 20-25 minutes walk to Wycliffe Hall, or a 10 minute bus ride, using Stagecoach Oxford route number 14 (see under 'BUS' above). There are taxi ranks in the station that depending on traffic will cost about £5 for a fare to the college. For more information on train services please contact:

### By car

**Major routes to Oxford:** London-Oxford: A40/M40/A40; Birmingham-Oxford: M40/A34; Bristol-Oxford: M32/M4/A34.

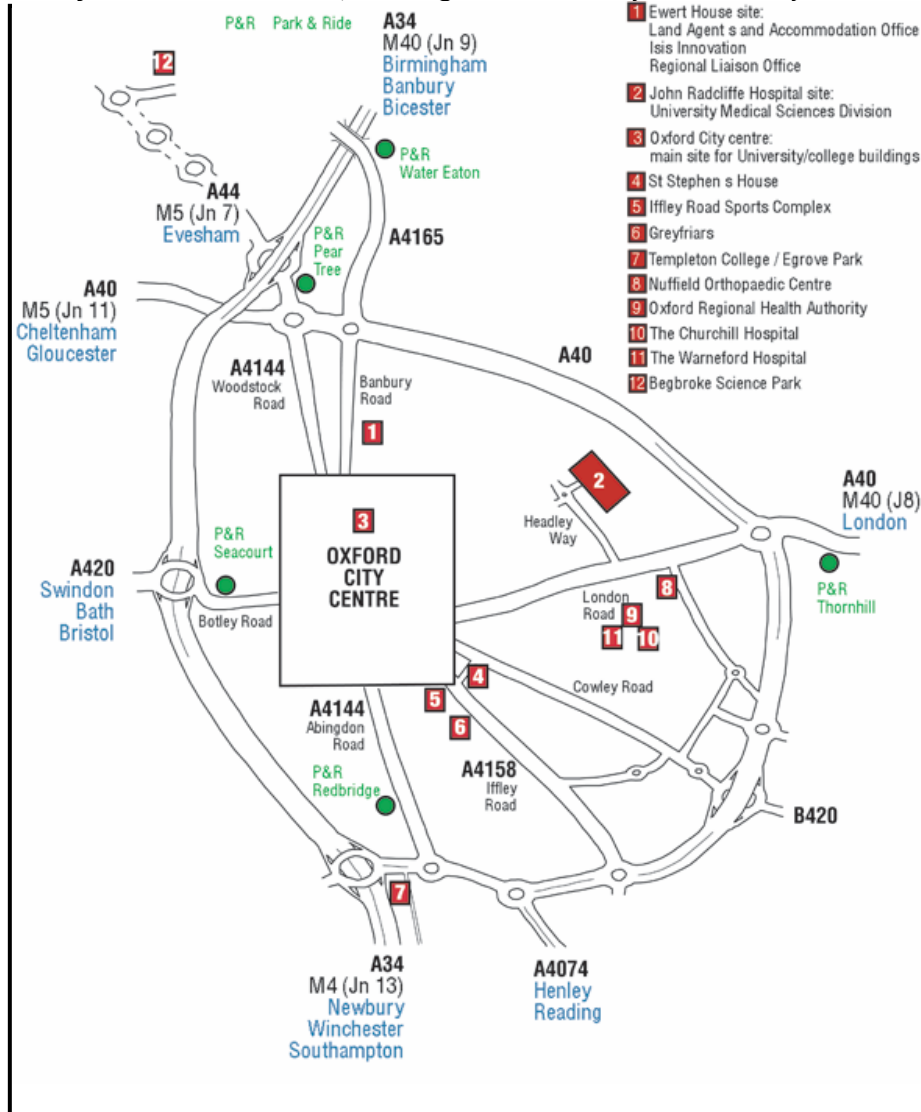
**Once in Oxford:** Take the ring road to the Cutteslowe Roundabout; Turn onto Banbury Road, heading South towards the City Centre (signed SUMMERTOWN); Keep heading straight for approx. 4 miles. Wycliffe Hall is on your left at 54 Banbury Road, Oxford, OX2 6PW.

Oxford can get **very** busy with cars. Wycliffe Hall has a car park and we can usually issue you with a parking permit if you provide us with the model, make, colour and registration number of your vehicle in advance. We have reserved blue-badge holder spaces. If you require one of these, please let us know in advance. Oxford has several Park and Ride services, two of which operate buses into the city centre which stop very close to Wycliffe Hall. Water Eaton Park and Ride buses stop at **Keble Road**, less than a five-minute walk from Wycliffe. Peartree Park and Ride buses stop at **Canterbury Road**, also a five to ten minute walk from the college. The buses take around 15 minutes from the car parks to Wycliffe Hall.
